

Zaner-Bloser Manuscript and Cursive Fonts

Manuscript & Manuscript on grids	Select ZB Manuscript or ZB Manuscript Grids from word processor's font menu before you type.
Blank Writing Grids for Manuscript	Select ZB Manuscript Grids font Type # as many times as needed
Blank Writing Grid One Line Only	Type # until the grid spills to the next line Then backspace once. DO NOT hit ENTER as it creates a solid line that cannot be removed easily.
Cursive	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Type text in the default font or any easy-to-read font (such as Times). 2. It is important to edit and spell-check now. 2. After typing the text, highlight it, & EDIT > CUT. Your text will disappear. 3. Now run the ZB Cursive Connector program by going to START > PROGRAMS > ZB CONNECTOR > ZB CURSIVE CONNECTOR 5. Once the text is converted, return to your document. 6. Position your cursor on the document page & EDIT > PASTE <p>Note: It is important to re-run the connector program each time you make a change to your cursive text. This will ensure that all the joinings between the cursive letters are perfect.</p> <p>Final Note: Depending on the word processor you use, there is a chance that when you paste your text back in to your document, it becomes unreadable. If that occurs, just select the unreadable characters and use your font menu to change it to ZB Cursive.</p>
Re-format the ZB Cursive text to another font	<p>Undo the letter connectors first</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Highlight and EDIT > CUT the text. 2. Run the ZB Cursive Undo Program. 3. Return to your document and EDIT > PASTE

ZB Cursive on Writing Grids	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Convert your text to connected cursive by using the cursive directions given in the fourth row above. 2. Then highlight the text and change the font to ZB Cursive Grids
Blank Writing Grids for Cursive	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select the ZB Cursive Grids font 2. Type # as many times as needed <p>Note: To form one complete line of writing grids, type # until the grid spills to the next line. Then backspace once.</p>
Printing	Don't be concerned if you notice gaps and imperfections in letters as they appear on your screen. The printed characters will look normal.
Point Sizes	<p>Kindergarten - 76 points</p> <p>Grade 1 - 64 points</p> <p>Grade 2 - 52 points</p> <p>Grades 3 & 4 - 40 points</p> <p>Grades 5 & up - 28 points</p>
